The programme to date includes:

Professor Edwin Gale from the UK, He will be addressing the topics of, 'The controversies in the treatment of type 1 and type 2 diabetes' and 'crystal ball gazing: the future of diabetes care'.

Professor Peter Shepherd returned from London in 2004 and his research continues in the broad area of signal transduction related to type-2 diabetes. Prof Shepherd's research aims to answer the questions: What is the role of PI 3-kinase in insulin signaling and cancer? and How do nutrients directly regulate cell signaling and cell function?

Assc Professor Merlin Thomas has a background of research in diabetes and renal disease and is renowned for his insightful talks giving the background to our clinical approach.

Professor Jim Mann will be hosting the primary care stream: which will be a case based discussion aiming to cover many of the difficult aspects of caring for the patient with diabetes rather than caring for the diabetes in the patient.
